



Full Day Photography Workshop

Thank you for choosing to join us on a full day photography workshop. Please read the following information for details on booking a date for your experience, what the day will involve, and anything you need to bring with you to ensure your day is as enjoyable as possible.

Itinerary

Your full day workshop will last approximately 6 hours, but please do allow a little time over that when arranging transport as the birds do not always work exactly according to schedule!

Your workshop will include 3 sessions. The first of the sessions will take place outdoors where you will have the chance to photograph the birds in a natural setting. For the second session you will move inside to a studio setting, so that you have the chance to photograph a wide variety of our birds in a controlled environment whatever the weather may be like on the day. The third session gives you the chance to photograph the birds while they are flying. We will fly some of the birds for you in a private flying session to give you the best chance of getting some great action shots.

You will also have the chance to take in one of our daily flying displays and lunch is included. There will be a professional photographer on hand throughout the workshop to give advice.

Booking Your Photography Workshop

Advance booking is essential for all of our workshops.

Please be aware that weekends and school holidays are particularly popular and busy times, and can book up quite a way in advance as we limit numbers for each day to make the workshop as enjoyable as possible for you.

Full day photography workshops run on specific dates throughout the year.

To book your workshop please call 01565 754419, and have your voucher to hand as we will need some of the details from it.

You may bring one spectator with you on your full day photography workshop at a cost of £25, and this can be paid on the day of your workshop. Please let us know when you book the date of your workshop if you are intending to bring a spectator. Spectators are not permitted to take photographs for the duration of the workshop. The minimum age for spectators is 16 years old.

Anybody under the age of 16 must have an adult spectator accompanying them.

Additional Information

Some of the workshop will take place outdoors, so please ensure you bring clothing suitable for the weather on the day. Please also wear a sturdy pair of shoes, sandals are not advised. If the weather has been wet around the time of your visit then walking boots or wellies may be more suitable than trainers. We suggest that you bring a tripod with you and if you have spare batteries or memory cards these would also be useful to bring with you.

Please bring your voucher along with you on the day.

For any workshops where the start time is before the general opening time of the centre of 11am, the doors will be opened for admission of participants 10 minutes before the workshop is due to begin.
